Happy Anniversary, CEF! In 2012 CEF will be celebrating her 75th anniversary. CEF has ministry in 176 nations. Our goal is to be in all 207 countries of the world by our 80th anniversary. God is moving in many parts of the world. . .



- In Sao Paulo, Brazil, CEF under contract with the government, has been teaching Good News Clubs in the public schools for over 45 years. In Brazil there are over 5,500 classes in the public schools with over 209,000 children reached on a weekly basis.
- CEF has 33 trained workers in Cuba who were able to reach 74,000 children in 2010. Nearly 700 Good News Clubs were held every single week.
- In Zimbabwe, one public school has over 1,400 children attending Good News Club every two weeks. In Zimbabwe AIDS has reduced the average life span to just 35 years of age. Many children do not live past the age of 12.
